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## ► Safe Travel (Packing tips)

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**Whether you're travelling inside Canada or beyond its borders, whether you're flying on business or on vacation, preparation is your ticket to a smoother trip.**

Remember these tips when packing for any journey:

- Ensure there are no sharp objects like scissors in your carry-on bag. Pack them in your checked luggage instead.
- Make sure electronic devices such as cell phones, laptop computers and portable or electronic games are charged and ready to be turned on for inspection. You will not be allowed to take them on board unless they are functioning.
- Pack prescription medication in its original labeled container. Syringes or needles for personal medical use must have the needle guard in place and also be accompanied by the medication in its original labeled container.
- Never wrap or package gifts. Security personnel may need to inspect them.
- Pack carefully. Be aware that any substances that might pose a risk to health, safety, property or the environment when transported, such as cleaning solvents or aerosols. These items are not permitted on board an aircraft.
- Pack your own bags; never let someone else do it.
- Never carry anyone else's bag through security – you will be responsible for the contents.
